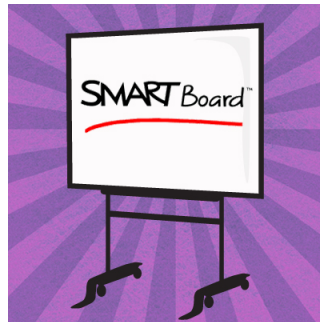

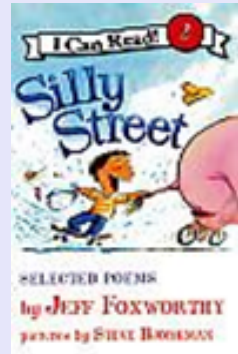

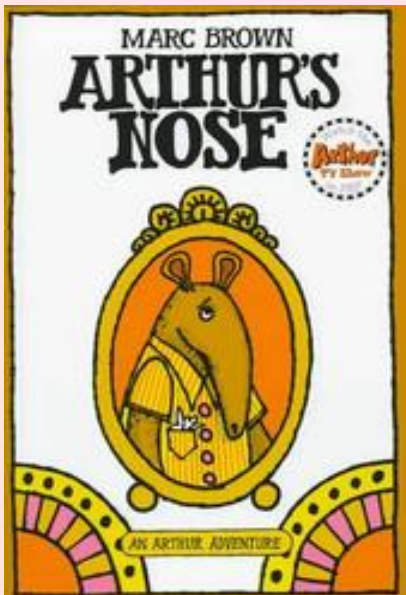

Shade Tool: Explanation

- Used to hide notes or important information until you want to show it
- Click on the picture of the shade screen on the top tool
- Use the grey dots at the edges of the shade to adjust size as needed



Camera & Screen Capture: Example



Camera & Screen Capture Tool: Explanation



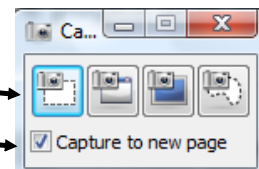
Useful for capturing part of or a whole screen.
Can capture pages and images from websites.

1. Click on the capture tool



2. A new screen will appear.

Notice this...



3. Then click on one of the four buttons.



*Select only the part of the screen you need.

Click on the button and then click and drag around what you want to capture.



Chunks of screen capture



Left click and drag around an object.

Color Reveal: Example

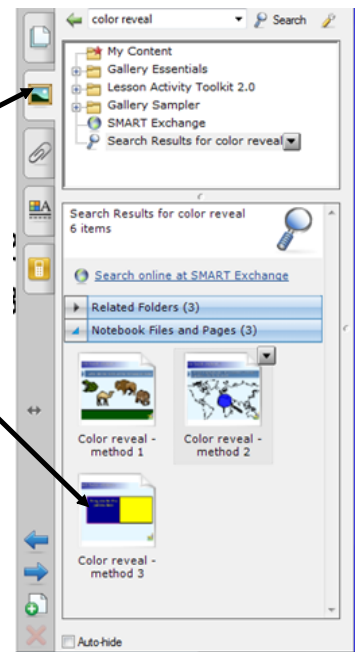
Martin's Big Words: The Life Martin Luther King, Jr. By Doreen Rappaport

Drag the question through the magic tunnel to reveal the genre.

Color Reveal: Explanation

1. Search "color reveal" in the Gallery
2. Under Notebook Files and Pages it is called "Color reveal - method 3"
3. Make the boxes wider so they don't reveal the words on the sides.
4. You can change the color by using the paint bucket.
5. Click on the words to change them.
6. Right click to ungroup, edit words and then regroup

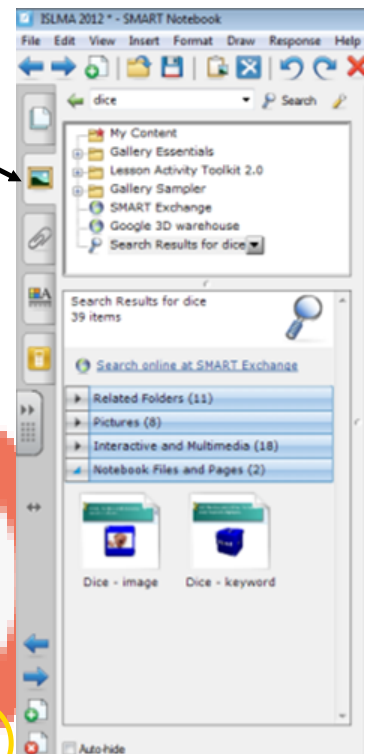
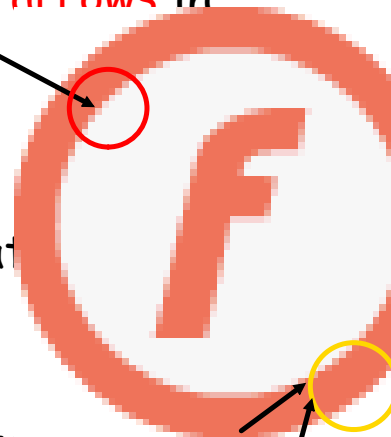

Dice: Explanation

1. Search "dice" in the Gallery
2. Under Notebook Files and Pages or Interactive and Multimedia it is called "Dice-image" and "Dice-keyword"
3. Click on the **two white arrows** in the top left corner.
4. Type in what you want the dice to say.
5. Click on the "No repeat box if needed.
6. Click to spin.
7. Click on **yellow arrow** to make list.
8. The **blue and white triangle** in the bottom right corner changes the size.



Vortex Sort: Example

Vortex: Explanation

1. Search "vortex" in the Gallery
2. Under Notebook Files and Pages or Interactive and Multimedia it is called "Vortex sort-image" and "Vortex sort-text."
3. Click on the **edit button** in the top left corner.
4. Type in what you want the vortex to say.
5. Avoid spinning vortex for health concern reasons.

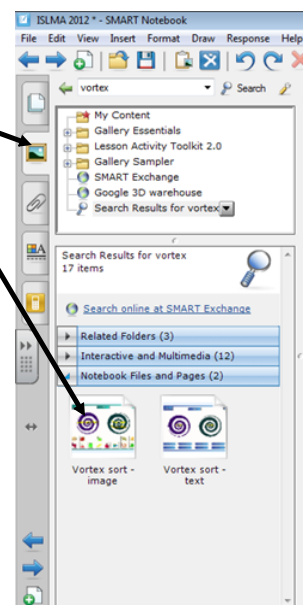


Image Select: Example

What's the Call Number?

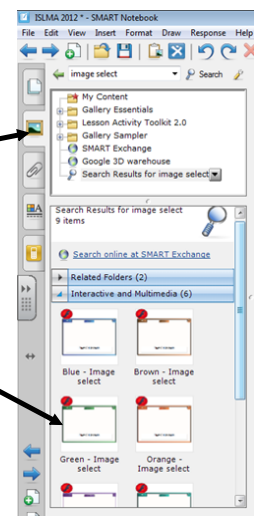
Click on the book cover. Then click the correct Call Number.

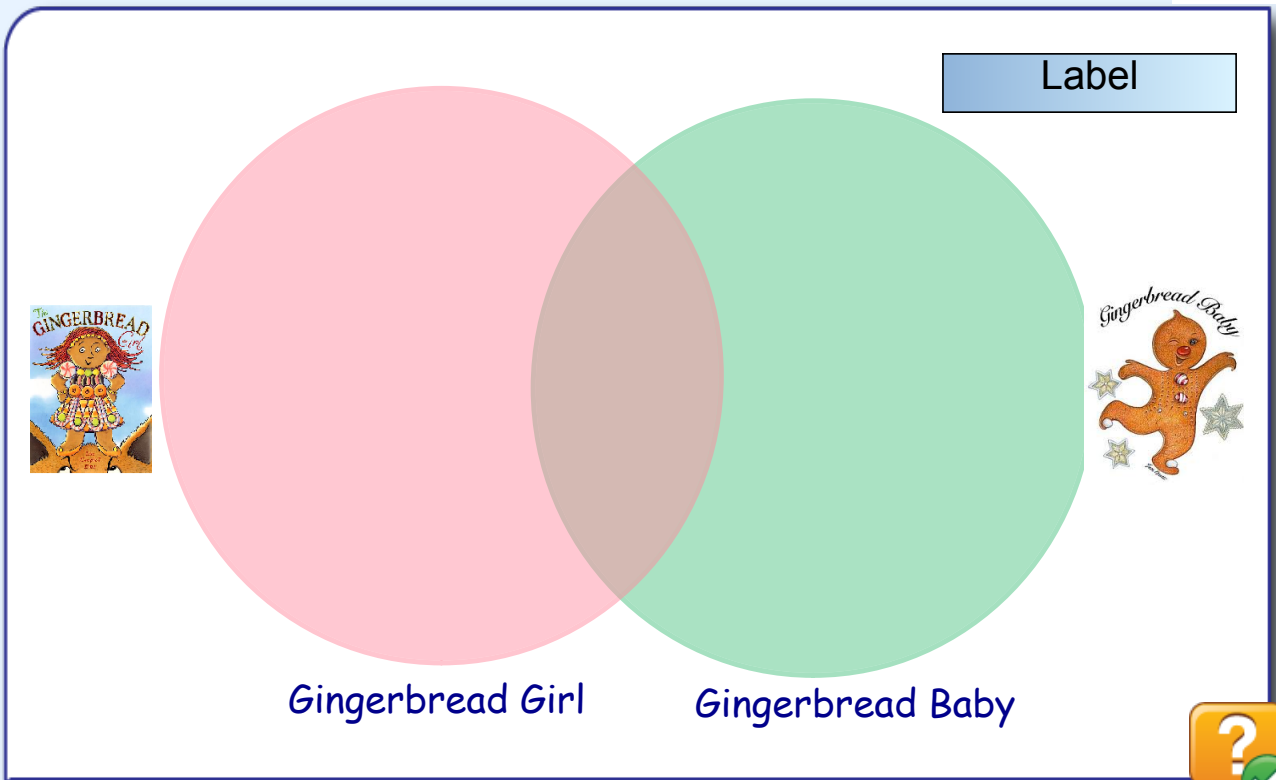
Image Select: Explanation

1. Search "image select" in the Gallery
2. Under Notebook Files and Pages or Interactive and Multimedia it is called "Image select" and "Color-Image select."
3. Click on the **edit button** in the top left corner.
4. Drag your pictures from your desktop into the boxes.
 - If you make a mistake, replace it with a different picture.
5. Type your words into the rectangles.






Venn diagram: Example

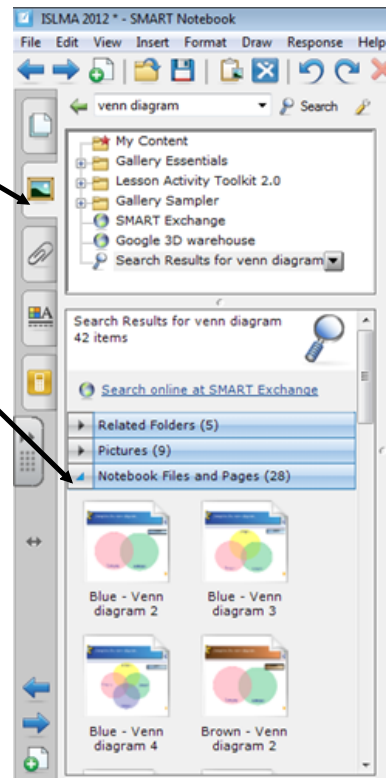
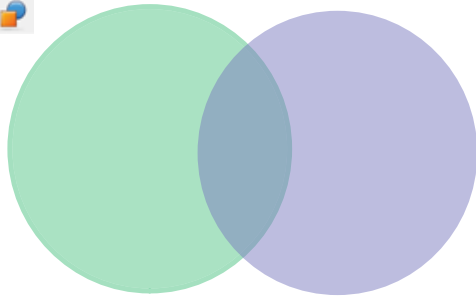

2. Under Notebook Files & Pages it is called "Venn diagram."
3. Type or add pictures as needed for your Venn Diagram.

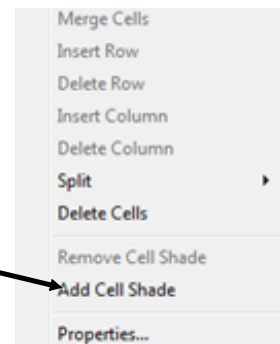

Word Guess: Example

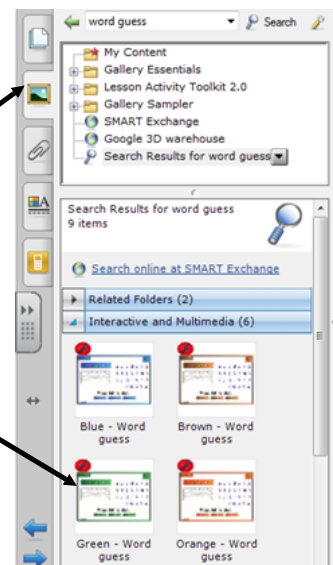
Can be a tomato splat, soccer or basketball

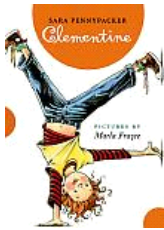


Word Guess: Explanation

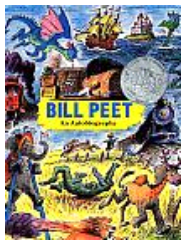
1. Search "word guess" in the Gallery
2. Under Notebook Files and Pages or Interactive and Multimedia it is called "Word Guess" and "Color-Word Guess."
3. Click on the **edit button** in the top left corner.
 - Type in your words and clues.
 - At the top choose soccer or tomato splat.



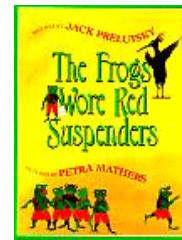
Magnifying Glass: Example



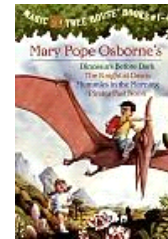
This story is about a girl who tries to be helpful to her friend, but ends up getting both of them in trouble.



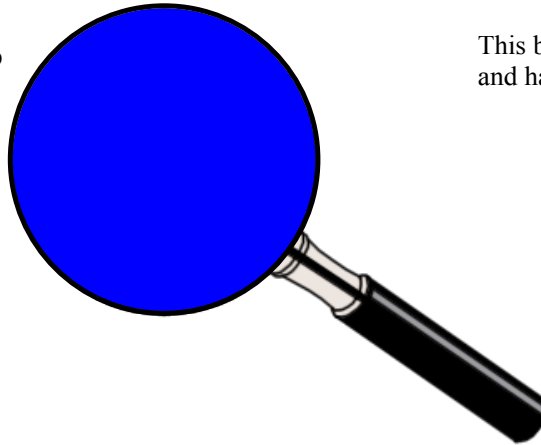
This book is written by the author about his own life.



This book is not a story, and has some short rhyming verses.

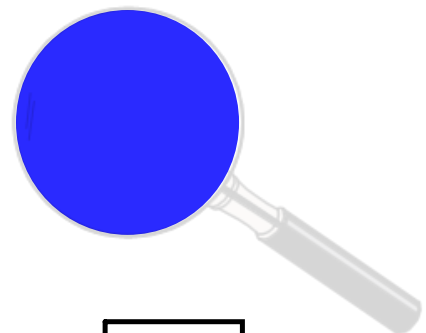
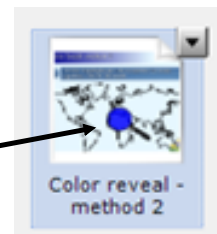


This story is about a brother and sister who get themselves in trouble in an imaginary land with dinosaurs.



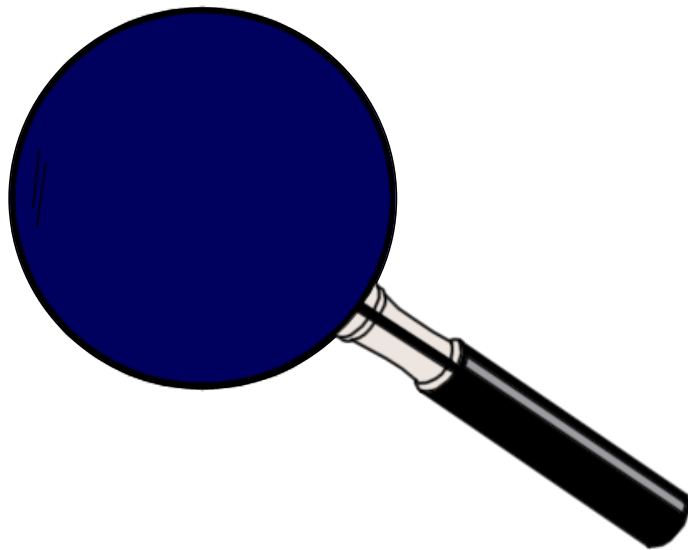
Magnifying Glass: Explanation

1. Search "reveal" in the Gallery
2. Under Notebook Files and Pages it is called "Color reveal- method 2"
3. Copy and paste the magnifying glass into a blank page.
4. Send the magnifying glass to the back
 - Right click on the glass and choose "send to back"
5. The reveal font has to be the same color as your background.



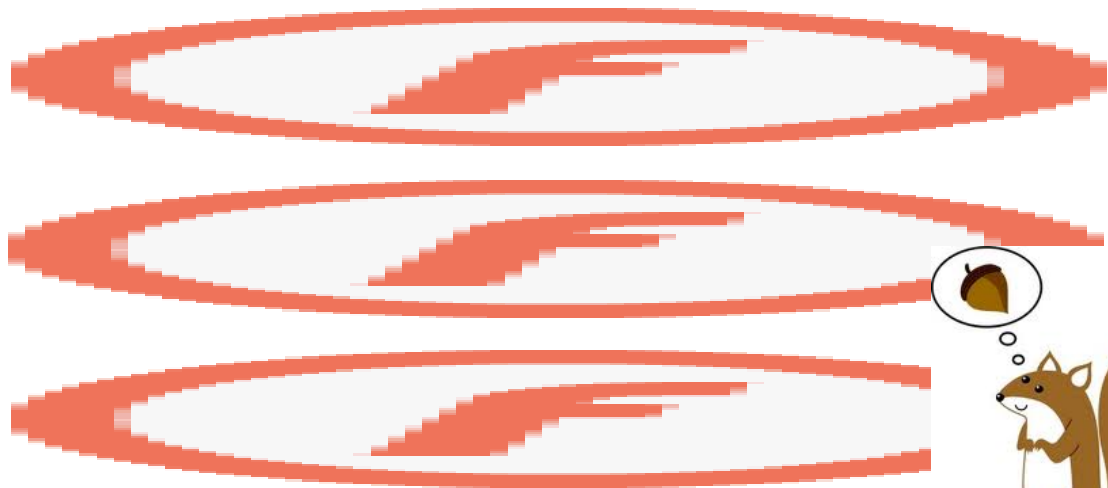
Magnifying Glass--not transparent

1. Group the magnifying glass with a circle
2. Change the color
3. Lock the magnifying glass and circle together.



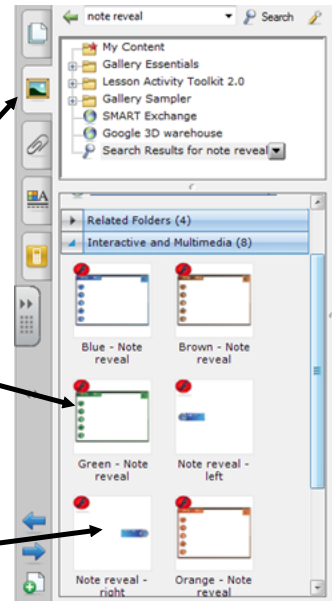

Note Reveal: Example

1. Search "Note reveal" in the Gallery ●
2. Under Notebook Files and Pages and Interactive and Multimedia it is called "Note reveal" and "Color-Note reveal"
 - The ? from the example is called "Note reveal-left/right." ●
3. Click on **edit button** in the top left corner.
4. Type your info in the rectangles.

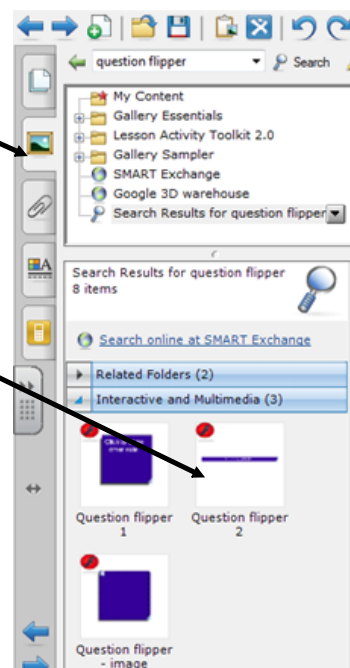


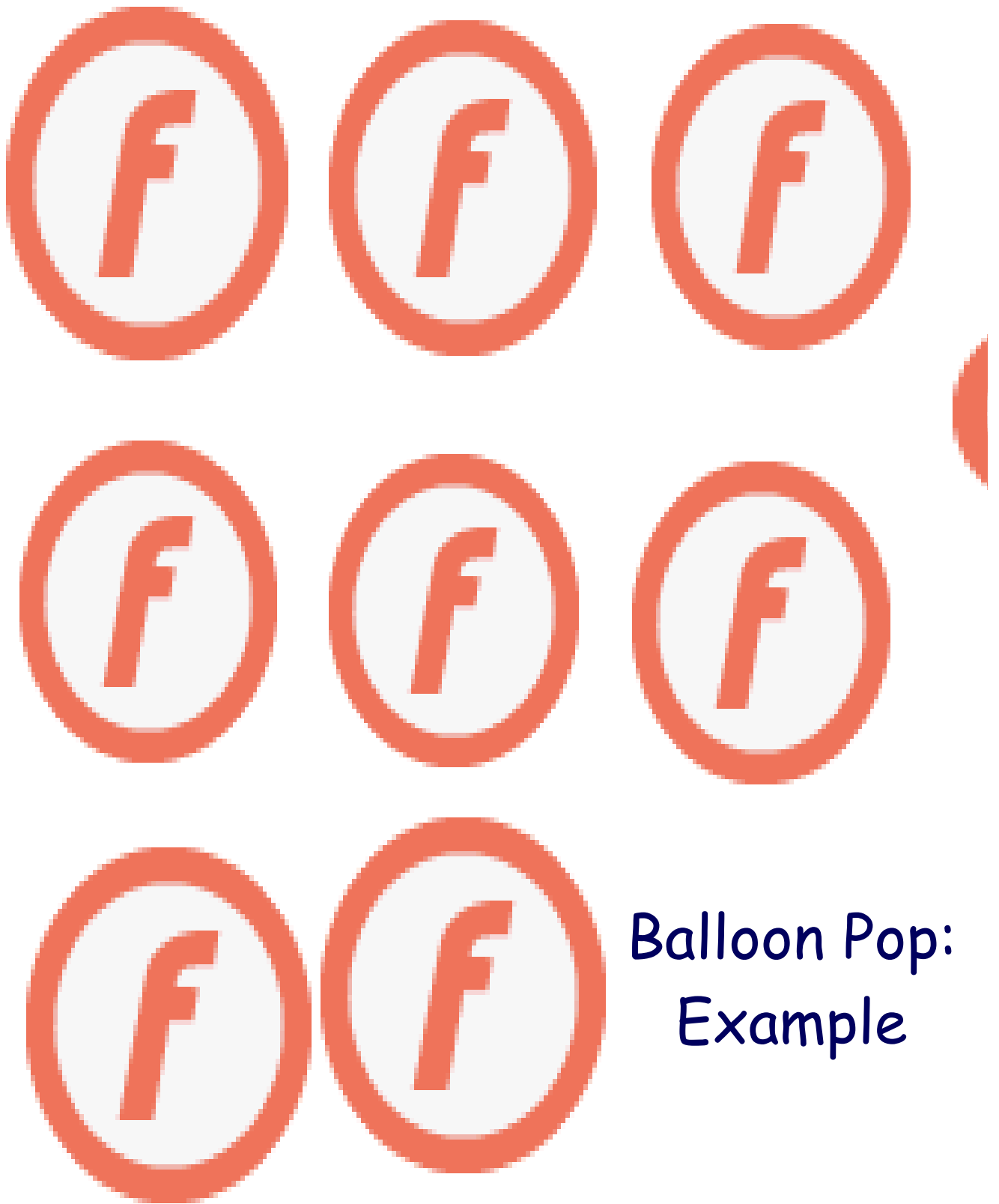
Question Flipper: Example



Question Flipper: Explanation

1. Search "question flipper" in the Gallery
2. Under Interactive and Multimedia it is called "Question flipper"
3. Click on **two white arrows** in the top left corner.
4. Type your info for the front and back using the tabs at the top.
5. You can change the font and background color as desired
6. The **blue and white triangle** in the bottom right corner changes the size

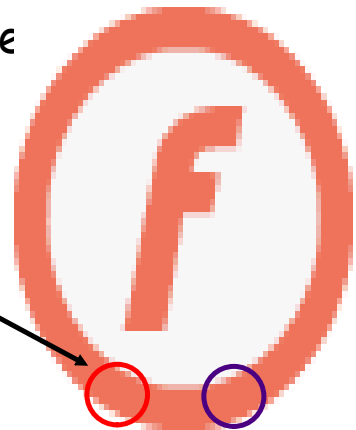




Balloon Pop:

Balloon Pop: Explanation

1. Search "balloon pop" in the Gallery
2. Under Notebook Files and Pages and Interactive and Multimedia it is called "Balloon pop"
3. Click on **two white arrows** in the bottom left corner.
4. Type your info in the box that appears.
5. The **blue and white triangle** in the bottom right corner changes the size.



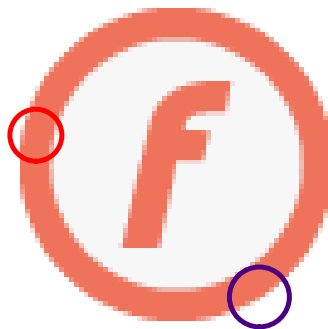
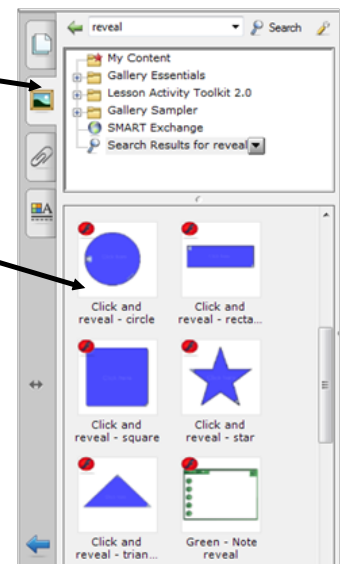
Click and Reveal Shapes: Example

What Print & Online Resources Do We Have?



Click and Reveal Shapes: Explanation

1. Search "reveal" in the Gallery
2. Under Interactive and Multimedia they are called "Click and reveal"
 - Come in many shapes
3. Click on the **two white arrows** in the top left corner to make changes to color
4. Make a text box and cover with your shape.
 - Text box needs to be made first.
5. The **blue and white triangle** in the bottom right corner changes the size.

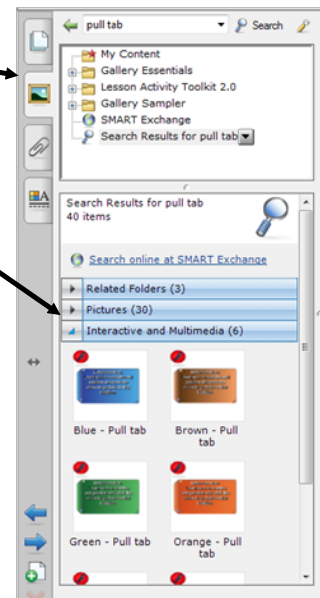
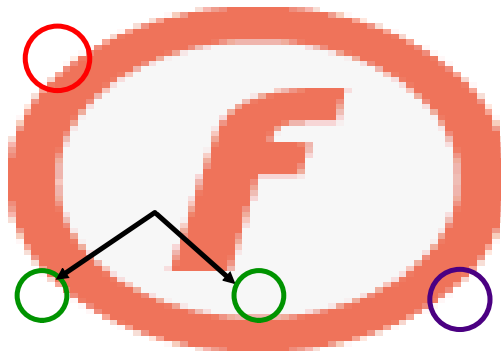


Three Easy Steps

Pull Tabs: Explanation

Great way to reveal directions or steps.

1. Search "pull tab" in the Gallery
2. Under Interactive and Multimedia they are called "Color-pull tab"
3. Click in the box to type in your text
4. Click on the **two white arrows** in the top left corner to change tab location, tab label and to add an image instead of text.
5. The **blue and white triangle** in the bottom right corner changes the size.

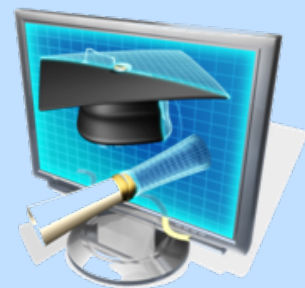
